Terms and Conditions

1. Each shipment must meet all regulations set forth in and governed by the Southwest Airlines Co. Official Cargo Contract of Carriage in effect at the time of shipment.
2. Rates are subject to the Terms and Conditions of Published Rates.
3. Rates are effective from 15JUN2009.
4. Rates do not include applicable taxes, surcharges, or fees and are subject to change without notice.
5. Perishable commodities can be shipped. When shipping commodities, the shipper must insert the perishable commodity code into the "Commodity Item Number" box on the air waybill, prior to the shipment being tendered.
6. Piece dimensions determined by combining the width, length, and height cannot exceed 90 inches. The single-piece weight limit cannot exceed 200 pounds. The single-piece Seafood weight limit cannot exceed 175 pounds.
7. Service to Canada is offered by our interline partner, WestJet Airlines. Shipments and rates to Canada are only available from select Southwest Airlines Cargo origin points to select Canadian destinations. For more information about shipping to Canada, please visit swacargo.com. RUSH Priority Freight is not available to these destinations at this time. Rates exclude interline origin cities.
8. All shipments tendered to Southwest Airlines Co. must have a preprinted Southwest Airlines International Air Waybill or Universal International Air Waybill reflecting the appropriate account number.
9. For Next Flight Guaranteed shipments:
 - a. Under 100 pounds, charges are based on the applicable chargeable weight break base charge.
 - b. Over 100 pounds, charges are based on the greater than 100 pounds weight break base charge, plus the applicable per pound rate for shipments over 100 pounds.
10. Standard NFG tender time restrictions apply and if not met, may render a shipment ineligible for this upgrade.
